Showcasing the work of BAYarts advanced ceramics community in support of education programming. The Danish concept of Hygge refers to finding comfort, pleasure, and warmth in simple, soothing things such as a cozy atmosphere, contentment and well-being through cherishing the little things.



Dawn finds her inspiration from paddle boarding on the Cuyahoga River and Lake Erie and studying the water, land, flora, and fauna from that perspective. The rhythm of the water, movement of the wind, and sounds of nature all have a direct impact on what Tekler brings to the canvas.



A lifelong sailor on Lake Erie, Robert Wagner is an oil painter who derives his inspiration from being on the water. This series of paintings focuses on Huntington Beach and Huntington Reservation. Wagner uses scenes from his photographs to capture the power and beauty of the natural landscape right in our own backvard.



David Hicks work is centered on the human figure or portrait in a narrative context; he metaphorically represents aspects of the human experience. The drawings reference history, myth, and pop culture. Hicks advises that the process of layering these symbolic figures and composing relationships between them is a cathartic way for him to apply meaning to bigger stories, both personal and universal to all.



Continuing her exploration of memory and gesture through found photographs, printmaking, and painting, Printz's new work expands technical and material boundaries. "My creative process generally starts with a level of discovery where I look through old photographs and contact sheets taken by family members over the last 100 years," says the artist. "I am the only child of only children, and in my father's case, two generations of avid photographers. So, I have a lot of material to explore." Through the meditative process of navigating the imagery, Printz finds hidden moments that she then develops into works on paper.

BAYarts collaborates with the Cleveland Photo Fest as a participating gallery. This photo exchange with Australia, centers on the classic theme of Mirrors and Windows: Each photograph is either a window through which you see the world, or a reflection of yourself and your own perspective of the world. Minor White championed and taught this theory in the 1950's and 1960s. The phrase was made popular by John Szarkowski of the Museum of Modern Art NYC who, in 1978 displayed a seminal (and one of the earliest major) photography exhibition of the same name. White was a friend and advocate of Alfred Stieglitz and adopted much of Stieglitz's theory of 'equivalence', where the image stands for something other than the subject matter.
